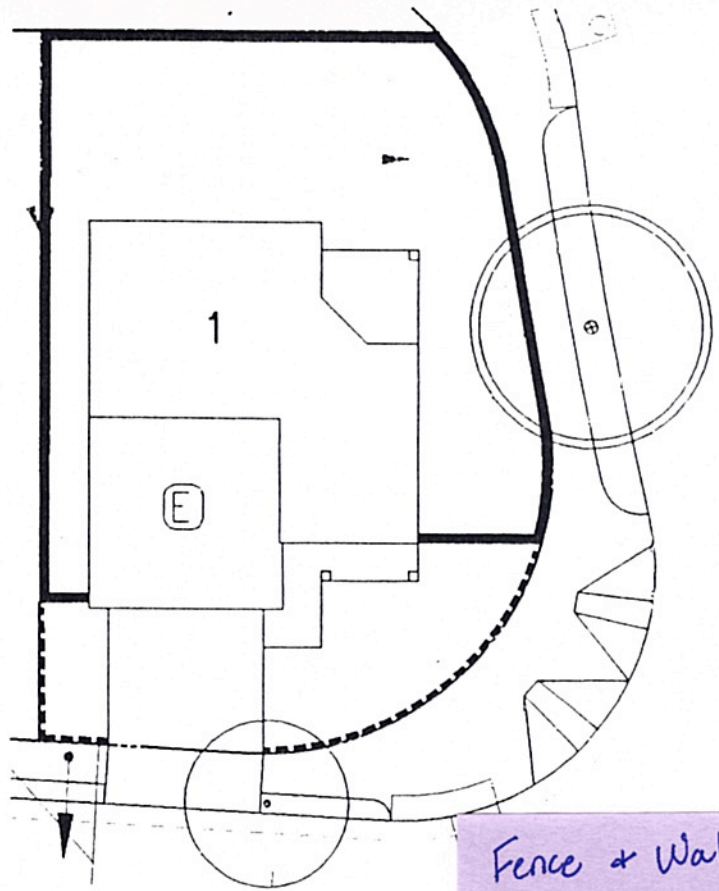


FENCE GUIDELINE NOTES

- FENCE WALL FOOTING SHOULD NOT PENETRATE THE UNDERLYING GEOGRIDS. IN GENERAL, THE GEOGRIDS EXTEND LATERALLY FROM ABOUT 8 FEET BEYOND THE KEYSTONE WALL AND VERTICALLY ABOUT 16" INCHES BELOW THE TOP OF THE KEYSTONE WALL.
- FENCE WALL FOOTING SHOULD BE EMBEDDED DEEP ENOUGH FOR AN ADEQUATE HORIZONTAL SETBACK FROM THE SLOPE FACE.
- FENCE WALLS SHOULD BE DESIGNED FOR CODE REQUIRED LOADS.
- THE SITE GRADE OF THE LOTS SHOULD NOT BE RAISED, AND THEREFORE, RETAINING WALLS SHOULD NOT BE CONSTRUCTED.

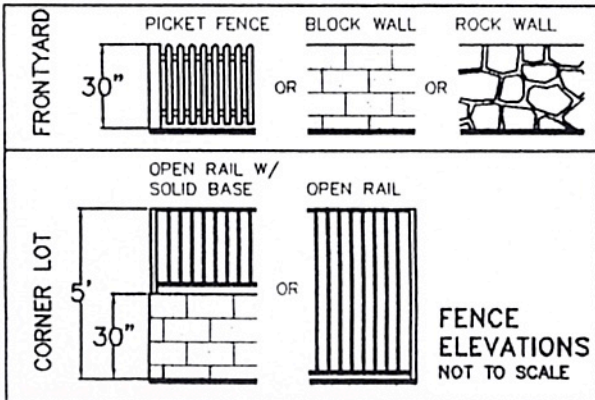

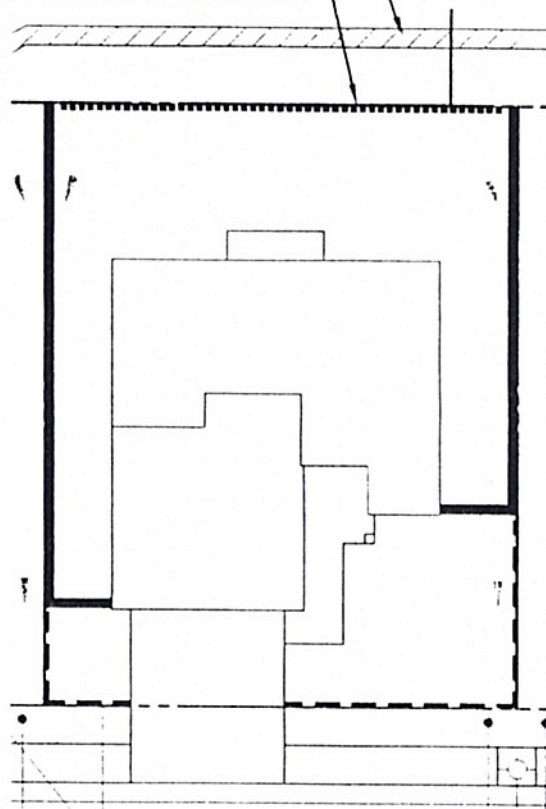

REAR YARD FENCING NOTES:

- FENCE WALLS SHOULD BE DESIGNED AND THE PLANS SHOULD BE STAMPED BY A CIVIL OR STRUCTURAL ENGINEER LICENSED IN THE STATE OF HAWAII.
- FENCE WALL FOOTING SHOULD NOT PENETRATE THE UNDERLYING GEOGRIDS. IN GENERAL, THE GEOGRIDS EXTEND Laterally FROM ABOUT 8 FEET BEYOND THE KEYSTONE WALL AND VERTICALLY ABOUT 16" INCHES BELOW THE TOP OF THE KEYSTONE WALL.
- FENCE WALL FOOTING SHOULD BE EMBEDDED DEEP ENOUGH FOR AN ADEQUATE HORIZONTAL SETBACK FROM THE SLOPE FACE.
- FENCE WALLS SHOULD BE DESIGNED FOR CODE REQUIRED LOADS.
